WORLD CHESS Grand Prix 2019 (HAMBURG, Germany) VISITOR RULES

- 1. For the purposes of these Rules the term "visitor" shall mean a person who is present within the venue of World Chess Grand Prix ("Event"), held from 4 to 17 November 2019 in Hamburg, Germany and shall include, but is not limited to players, their team members, media representatives, spectators, volunteers, contractors, personnel and guests of the Event. The Event is organized by World Chess Events Limited, hereinafter referred to as "Organizer".
- 2. Entrance to the venue of the Event constitutes acceptance by visitor of these Rules.
- 3. Visitors who do not comply with these Rules will not be permitted to the venue of the Event or will be expelled from the venue. If the behavior of a visitor, which is contrary to the Rules, results in direct or indirect damage to the Organizer, the Organizer shall have the right to hold the visitor liable for such actions.
- 4. The visitors shall:
- 4.1. Observe and maintain public order and generally accepted norms of behavior when within the venue and/or the surrounding areas;
- 4.2. Behave respectfully towards other visitors and participants of the Event, personnel, the persons responsible for compliance with the order, avoid actions that create danger to others.
- 4.3. AT THE TOURNAMENT VENUE THE VISITORS SHALL NOT:
- 4.3.1. PERFORM PHOTO-SHOOTING OR VIDEO-RECORDING WITHIN THE PLAYING AREA WITHOUT A WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF THE FIDE PRESS OFFICER;
- 4.3.2. MAKE LOUD SOUNDS, TALK, USE THE TELEPHONE OR ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICE WITHIN THE PLAYING AREA;
- 4.3.3. try to access the zones outside of those prescribed by his or her ticket.
- 5. Visitor will not be allowed to enter the venue if his or her body odor or physical hygiene might disturb the reasonable comfort of other visitors or personnel or if he or she is inebriated and/or under the influence of illegal substances. Odors may include but are not limited to scents related to unlaundered clothing, lack of bathing, animal related odors, and excessive perfumes.
- 6. Organizer is not responsible for any personal belongings of the visitors (including clothes left at the wardrobe).
- 7. These rules may be amended from time to time at Organizer's sole discretion.
- 8. From 5th to 17th November, the doors open for public at 14:00, one hour before the games start. The venue closes 30 mins after the last game finishes.

All guests get a check-in bracelet upon registration.

Visitors with check-in bracelets can leave the venue and return without any restrictions.

Animals are not allowed at the tournament venue. Children under 4 years old are not allowed in the Game area. Smoking on site is prohibited.
