## Terms and conditions

Any interruption/cancellation of the Locarno Film Festival due to force majeure, external influences (events, threats from third parties, pandemics, epidemics, etc.), bans by federal, cantonal and municipal authorities or other circumstances not attributable to the Locarno Film Festival will result in the automatic termination of the hospitality offers presented in this document with no further consequences for the Locarno Film Festival other than those indicated in the last paragraph of this text.

The Parties declare themselves aware of the possibility that the 76th edition of the Festival may be cancelled as a result of an order issued by the local, cantonal, federal or international authorities within the framework of a situation of force majeure (such as in the event of an epidemic or pandemic, particularly in relation to COVID-19).

Even in the absence of a regulatory provision or a decision by an authority, the Locarno Film Festival may, at any time and when circumstances require, for reasons of urgency, necessity or to safeguard overriding public or private interests (in particular in the context of a situation of force majeure such as in the case of an epidemic or pandemic, particularly in relation to COVID-19) cancel the offers of hospitality presented in this document, thereby terminating any contractual relationship without further consequences for the Locarno Film Festival, other than those indicated in the last paragraph of this text.

The Locarno Film Festival reserves the right to offer to the buyer, in case of cancellation of the hospitality offers for the reasons mentioned above, as an alternative to a cash refund, a voucher of the same value as the price of the package purchased. This voucher can only be used to purchase Locarno Film Festival hospitality offers.
